Oxford: A world-class city for everyone was adopted as Oxford's Sustainable Community Strategy by the Oxford Strategic Partnership in September 2008.

The Strategy states a vision of making Oxford a world class city for everyone and has identified a cross cutting theme of the economy in the city and five flagship issues where the Partnership feels it can add value:

- Affordable Housing
- Health and Social Inclusion
- Climate Change
- Quality of the Public Realm for Visitors and Residents
- Safer Stronger more Cohesive City
